Insulating Concrete Forms

How ICF's are advancing "Green" building in Kentucky

Insulating concrete forms continue to be one of the largest growing segments of the construction industry in Kentucky. The state of Kentucky leads the nation in ICF schools and this success in the school market is carrying over into other areas. Hotels, hospitals, offices and homes are just a few other areas where ICF's are having growing success. The recent movement toward "green" building practices has led a lot of owners and architects to consider using ICF's in their design. This seminar is going to provide a brief overview of the ICF construction process, provide real world examples, project profiles and provide an opportunity to walk through a project under construction at a nearby site after the seminar. We will also be examining the energy demands from several completed residential and commercial buildings. Insulating concrete forms provide an energy efficient building shell, while providing the strength of a concrete building. ICF's have also been used because of their speed of construction compared to other building methods and because winter conditions do not deter construction. Insulating concrete forms are no longer an experimental or unconventional method of construction.
