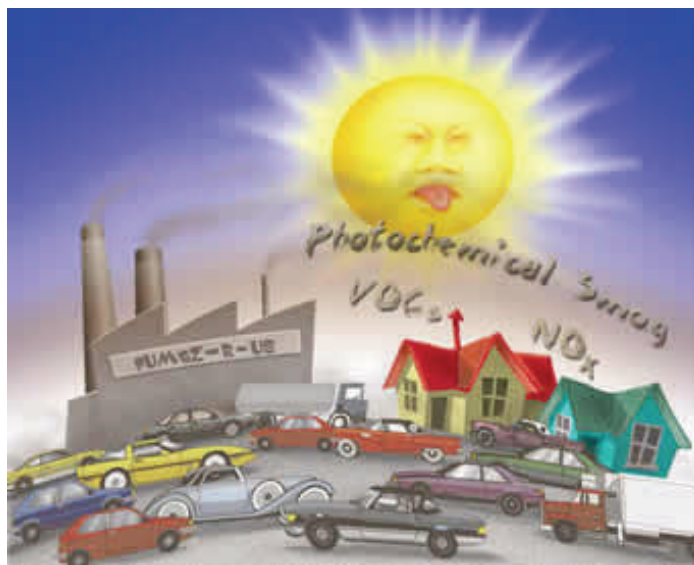

VOC Law Changes Affecting Concrete Joint Meeting With ICRI

EPA regulations that limit the amount of VOC (volatile organic content) in concrete construction products are becoming more prevalent – and stricter – on state and local levels. In January 2009, Ohio enacted a VOC law that significantly changes the types of construction products that are legal for sale and use in the state. Most significantly, use of concrete curing compounds and cure & seals complying with ASTM C1315 and C309 will be affected. Jennifer Crisman, from The Euclid Chemical Company, will explain the background and implications of this new law and present the product options for Ohio in 2009 and beyond.

Jennifer is a Technical Marketing Manager with 13-years of experience in formulating and marketing Euclid's concrete curing compounds, sealers, coatings and joint fillers. In her current position, she manages Euclid Chemical's Technical Support Group, supports the marketing activities associated with new construction product development, and develops the technical content of Euclid Chemical's product literature. Edison Cement

"One of the metropolitan area's earliest and most outspoken concrete evangelists was Thomas Edison, who built a colossal portland-cement mill in New Village, New Jersey, in 1899, and whose lifetime list of a thousand and ninety-three United States patents includes forty-nine related directly to cement or concrete. For a few years in the early nineteen-hundreds, his company circulated a monthly brochure called *The Edison Aggregate*, and in 1926 it published an effusively hortatory promotional book called 'The Romance of Cement' (first chapter: 'The Eternal Romance of Cement')."
