Steve Waalkes, MS, P.E. and the State of Michigan are leading the nation in long concrete overlays, often over asphalt. Quarter mile, mile half mile, one mile. Overlays are being bid across the Nation in the ARRA Stimulus effort, as they can be designed and done quickly, efficiently and economically. The picture below right of Patterson Avenue is a mile overlay with the main pavement done in 6 days. Mr. Waalkes will explain how concrete can offer speed, aesthetics, design flexibility, enhanced safety, reduce yearly lighting costs, strength and durability, great environmental benefits, and life cycle costs that can save the owner thousands of dollars over the years. Mr. Waalkes has given workshops across North America, is a member of ACI 325 Concrete Pavements and the Transportation Research Board. He also specializes in concrete Roundabouts.
