- * The Ohio EPA 4th Generation Industrial Storm Water General Permit (NPDES Permit No. OHR000004) including Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans and Storm Water Monitoring.
- * The Ohio EPA General Air Permitting Program including the Application Process and the Permit Terms and Conditions for Ready Mixed Concrete Plants.
- * The Draft Ohio EPA Industrial Waste Rules (OAC 3745-525) and the potential impact on the Ready Mixed Concrete Industry in Ohio.
